	Minimum Eligibility Requirements to achieve
Young Horse Championship <b>6 years old</b>	<p>Obtain an MER according to 2025 FEI Eventing Rules, article 517 criteria as a combination between 01 January 2024 to 15 September 2025 at <b>1 CCI2*-S</b> with the following additional criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ zero obstacle penalties on XC (The 1st activation of a frangible /deformable device (11 penalties) or having 1 Missed flag (15 penalties) will still allow a MER.)</li> <li>➤ max 4 penalties on obstacles (max one rail down) in the Jumping test</li> </ul>
Young Horse Championship <b>7 years old</b>	<p>Obtain MERs according to 2025 FEI Eventing Rules, article 517 criteria as a combination between 01 January 2024 to 15 September 2025 at <b>1 CCI2*-L</b> and <b>1 CCI3*-S</b> with the following additional criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ both with zero obstacle penalties on XC (The 1st activation of a frangible /deformable device (11 penalties) or having 1 Missed flag (15 penalties) will still allow a MER.)</li> <li>➤ both with max 4 penalties on obstacles (max one rail down) in the Jumping test</li> </ul> <p>In addition to the above requirements, combinations must meet the MERs for CCI3*-L as per article 520. For Uncategorised Athletes, this would result in obtaining an additional MER at CCI3*-S.</p>

### FEI Eventing Rules. Article 517 – Minimum Eligibility Requirement

A Minimum Eligibility Requirement is achieved by completing a Competition within minimum parameters of all round performance as follows:

- Dressage Test: not more than 45 penalty points (or 55%).
- Cross Country Test:
  - A clear round at obstacles (activating a maximum of one frangible device or having a maximum of one missing flag will maintain the MER result on Cross Country)
  - Not more than 75 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross-Country Test for, two, three and four star level Competitions and 100 seconds in the case of five star level Competitions.
- Jumping Test: not more than 16 penalties at obstacles.

NOTE: All MERs obtained in previous years will be counted according to the rules in place at that time.

The Team Manager will pay special attention to:

- Overall performance throughout the year and readiness to compete at CH-W in October
- Show jumping (at Le Lion this is very influential)

These following shows can be good shows for horses in the build up to Le Lion:

- CCI Orp Le Grand → 01-04/05
- CCI Jardy → 10-13/07
- CCN Nokere → 01-03/08 → Belgian Championship
- CCI Arville → 13-17/08

None of these shows are compulsory. If you have questions about where to compete and how certain shows are to be expected, you can contact the Team Manager.

The riders who are candidate to participate at the World Championship need to be proactive:

- Send a mail to the Team Manager ([ksmeventing@aol.com](mailto:ksmeventing@aol.com)) & Sport Director ([wendy@equibel.be](mailto:wendy@equibel.be)) with the confirmation they are interested in participating at Le Lion. **The deadline to do this is before CCN Nokere. So 1/08 is the deadline.**
- Enter their candidature for Le Lion on [www.equibel.be](http://www.equibel.be) when the show is "open for candidatures"
- Send videos to the Team Manager of the horse in competition.

The Team Manager will present his proposal of selection to the Topsportcel (senior eventing) for approval. The definite selection will be communicated in the 10 days before the nominative entries.
